

## Official “Do the Write Thing” Logo Contest Guidelines

*Please read the following rules and regulations before beginning your design. Review them with your parent or legal guardian and complete the required form. Failure to do so will disqualify your entry.*

- To be eligible, participants must be in the 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, or 8<sup>th</sup> grade.
- All entries must be received by U.S. Mail no later than **Monday, March 15, 2010.**
- All entries must be submitted with the completed consent statement signed by the participant and the participant’s parent or legal guardian. The consent statement can be found at: [www.dtw.org](http://www.dtw.org)
- Any entry without the signed consent statement will not advance in the selection process.
- Personal information should not appear on the logo design, only on the consent statement.
- Entries are to be submitted on an 8 ½” x 11” plain white sheet of paper. Only one side of the paper may be used.
- Entries may be drawn or printed, using black and white or color.
- All entries must be the original work of the participant.
- Only one entry per person is permitted.
- The winner will be announced and notified on Monday, May 3, 2010.
- The winner will receive a new laptop as well as a trip, accompanied by one parent or legal guardian, to Washington, D.C. from July 10-14, 2010, for the “Do the Write Thing Challenge” National Recognition Ceremony.
